Scholar agreements for 2021-2023

Reminder: **56 days of scholars per PSRS promotion are required**. The guest speakers must be in presence of the students (no online scholars). Payment is optional and modular.

- Currently 4 scholars planned at UJM for a total of 38 days (CSEM, University of Toulouse, University of Moncton, OQmented) => Vote unanimously in favour of all 4 scholars.
- 1 day for 1 or 2 scholars will be added by POLiTo (Bosch).

PSRS budget

The sharing rules between the full partners are the same as for 2021-2022.

Money left over by abandoned scholarships will be used to create new EMJMD scholarships for the last cohort.

19 EMJMD scholarships (7 for programme country students, 12 for partner country students) should be accessible to the 4th cohort in 2023-2025.

Organization of the « blank intake » after EU fundings

A new EMJM PSRS project will be submitted in 2024 to pursue the programme.

However, even in case of success, the fifth cohort (2024-2026) will not be funded by EMJMD scholarships.

The programme will continue with UJM, UPEC, UEF for the fifth cohort and will propose eight or nine 22 k€ PSRS scholarships to this cohort with free tuition fees, provided that the UJM governing body validate the delivery of the scholarships. Students will pay for their own ordinary insurance.

UPEC would deliver online courses in that case (to be validated with the EACEA).

The consortium decides to save money to the 2 next years to fund the PSRS scholarships in 2024-2026.

PSRS budget 2

Budget for 2022-2023 and 2023-2024 is redistributed according to the saving planned.

Promotion of PSRS

Alumni, and M1&2 students will be asked to promote the master in their former universities and among their network.
