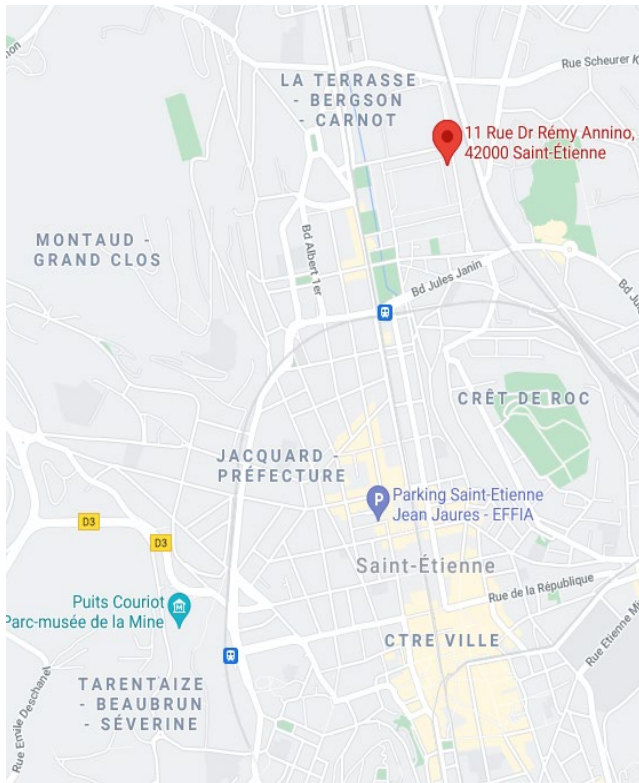

The primary areas of research at NAVER LABS Europe are computer vision, natural language processing, and machine learning and optimization.

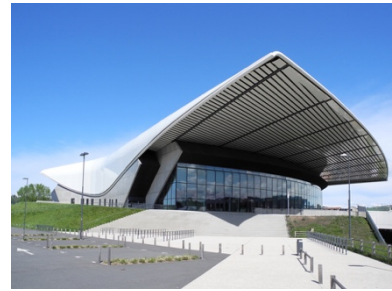
